Yes Ma'am! That is definitely welcome! However, there are two really easy ways to pay without using the Bulls as a middleman. Here are three ways:

Pay Online: <https://interland3.donorperfect.net/weblink/weblink.aspx?name=crf&id=1>. For Haiti earthquake relief, check ONE-TIME GIFT. Under "I want my gift to be used for" click CURRENT NEED. Then type **HAITI EARTHQUAKE RELIEF** in comments box. Email me the confirmation of your donation.
Pay by check: Make check payable to Christian Relief Fund and fill out the attached form and mail it in. The address is on the form.
Pay by phone: Call **1-800-858-4038**. They accept Visa, Mastercard, Novus, American Express or **Automatic Draft**

The organization we are donating to is the Christian Relief Fund (CRF), a CFC organization based out of Amarillo, TX. We chose CRF for a few reasons.

They are not taking any processing or admin fees for the Haiti Relief. 100% of donation go down to Haiti. They have a pre-existing network in Haiti from before the Earthquake, enabling more effective outreach to those in need.

They are a CFC organization and are accredited by the Evangelical Council for Financial Accountability, an independent accounting organization.

So, CS-06 can channel funds, but I really recommend using the above mentioned ways. Let me know what you think and thank you for your efforts!
