Subject: laundry issues

I've been told that on one of the parents forums there is discussion about the laundry service and that the clothes are all washed inside the bag and they don't come out clean, etc. I called the person in charge of laundry services and was told all the basics were issued two mesh bags and a regular green bag. The mesh bags have instructions to put in "white underwear and socks only" or "dark underwear and socks only." There is also a mesh bag for the ladies for their "delicates." All other items go into the green bag and the cadets are instructed to fill out a laundry ticket with pertinent information. The person I spoke to said there are explicit instructions on the bags.

Apparently, it's being said (on the forum) that the laundry service doesn't use detergent, that everything is just boiled, and all the laundry is left in the bag and thrown in the wash and when it's returned the clothes are not clean and still in the bag. I'm told this is not true. The shirts even arrive on hangers!

In the past during basic training, if the cadets did not put their laundry in the correct bags they were returned. Due to time restraints, currently (during BCT), if the laundry isn't in the correct bag, it goes to the laundry "as is" and is possibly returned still in the bag.
