I checked with the post office and although their policy is to return or "dead file" anything which isn't addressed correctly, they do make an exception for the new cadets. If you wish to send a package that will go to a cadet who doesn't normally receive anything, it should be addressed as follows:

USAFA CO 80841

The post office is kind enough to set aside these packages and "watch" for cadets who don't receive anything. They will give out these packages to those cadets.

The PAK MAIL store (packages sent via UPS or Fed Ex) does not do this – only the post office.
